Lilly and Goodrich Scholarships Awarded

The Community Foundation partnered with the Winchester Foundation to present the 2010 Lilly and Goodrich Scholarships. Traditionally these awards have been presented at separate times. Combining the announcements provides an opportunity to recognize both the recipients of the two prestigious scholarships and those who were finalists.

The Lilly Endowment Scholarships were presented by Larry Hall, Chair of the CFRC Scholarship Committee, to Gabriel Winkle, a graduate of Winchester High School and Kyler Naylor, a graduate of Randolph Southern. The alternate for the Lilly Scholarship is Emily Lumpkin, a graduate of Union High School. The Lilly Scholarship is a 4-year scholarship, covering all tuition, required fees and a book stipend. The Alternate receives a \$1,000 scholarship from the Community Foundation.

The Goodrich Scholarship was awarded to Jaelyn Saulmon, a graduate of Winchester High School, by Dane Starbuck, representing the Winchester Foundation. The Goodrich Scholarship is a 4-year scholarship that does not carry the restriction of being used for tuition only. Jaelyn was also selected as a recipient of the Lilly Scholarship and had to make a difficult decision of choosing between the two. She chose the Goodrich.

Finalists for the Lilly Scholarship, each receiving a \$500 scholarship from the Community Foundation, are: Adam Barga, UCHS; Mark Daly, WCHS; Cierra Edwards, WCHS; Amelia Ordonez, MCHS; Jaelyn Saulmon, WCHS; Haylie Thomas, MCHS; and Jordan Wall, WCHS. Finalists for the Goodrich Scholarship, all graduates of Winchester High School, are Mark Daly, Cierra Edwards, John Milner, John Oswalt, Jordan Wall, Nicole Wilber and Gabriel Winkle.

Both the Community Foundation and the Winchester Foundation congratulate all Randolph County graduates. The Boards of both foundations agree that the quality of students is outstanding.

This year, the Community Foundation presented a total of 74 scholarships worth \$47,450 to Randolph County graduates, not counting the Lilly.

The Community Foundation of Randolph County's mission, stated above, reflects how the organization operates. The gifts of individuals, groups and businesses are invested for the purpose of providing grants for the benefit of the county. These grants may be scholarships or a grant to a non-profit organization serving and improving the lives of County residents. Twice a year the Foundation accepts grant requests for funding of projects and organizations.

A grants committee consisting of CFRC board members and community advisors, review the grant applications and determine what grants will be funded along with the level of funding. When making the decisions, the committee always con-

siders the quality of the organization and its pro-

jects and programs, as well as how the residents of the county are served. The committee always strives to fund projects with the highest impact to the County.

Grants awarded through the semi-annual cycle are awarded from the Community Foundation Community Enrichment Fund and the Union City Community Fund. The Board of Directors just approved the spring grant and \$13,000 will be distributed as follows:
