# Spring Grants Awarded

The Community Foundation awarded \$66,236.70 in grants to local non-profit organizations at a reception in Union City. Sixteen organizations received at least some of the funds requested to complete their projects. 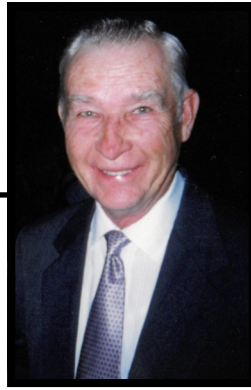

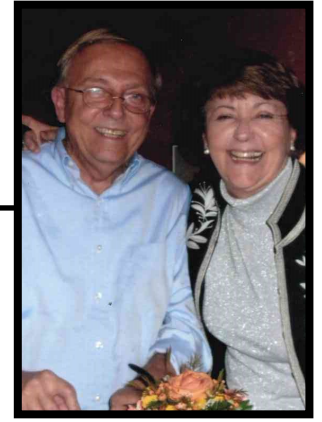
