The Community Foundation of Randolph County is pleased to announce our annual Women's Fund Brunch and Auction on Saturday, August 10, 2024, at St. Joseph Catholic Church Parish Hall in Winchester, Indiana. As part of the celebration, an art contest will precede the Brunch and Auction, and we hope that all local artists will consider participating!

Last year, the first-place award was \$500 and second- and third-place artists each received \$250 awards. The 2024 Brunch and Auction will follow suit, including awards for the top three art pieces. **We would love for you to be part of our event!**

Each artist may submit a single entry to the contest, and each entry will be eligible for a cash prize. All prize-winning artworks will be sold during the Auction on August 10th.

On submission, each artist will elect whether, in the event their artwork does not win a prize, to donate the artwork for the Auction. All proceeds from sold artwork help fund grants for projects that empower the women and children of Randolph County. Furthermore, please note that, due to the numerous submissions received, each submitted artwork will be eligible for prizes, but it is possible that not all artworks will be auctioned.

This year's theme is "Life's A Peach: Celebrating Fourteen Years of Paying It Forward," but you are not required to incorporate the theme into your artwork. Mediums of all types will be accepted but should be a size and weight that will allow one person to carry it. Pieces should be stable when on a flat surface and/or be able to be hung on the wall.

We ask that you title your artwork and deliver it to the Community Foundation of Randolph County on Monday, July 22nd, or Tuesday, July 23rd, from 8am to 4:30pm. Art will be judged on Wednesday, July 24th. <u>Prize winners will be notified no later than</u> Friday, July 26th and recognized at the brunch on August 10th.
